Bangkok: Mapping transport choices – and aspirations



14% trips by walking and non-motorized vehicles/mostly women & youth



31% trips by motorcycle

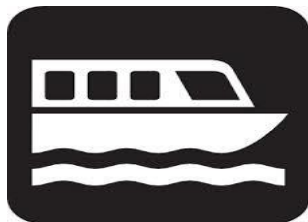


0.6 m trips per day are made on BTS and MRT



9.5 m trips a day are made by car

Every month 52,000 cars are added onto Bangkok streets
